Permyjaya Miri recorded "Very Unhealthy" IPU(Air Pollution Index) on Aug-18th,2018 as reported in the main news channel. Also seen on photo, BOMBA and DOE members in an onsite operation to put off bush fire to reduce hazy air surrounding the area following long dry & hot weather in Miri.

The lengthy dry weather in Miri has recently caused wildfires to flare up around Miri division, especially in the Kuala Baram, Permyjaya and Prima Villa area. As a result of these wildfires, haze has also return to most part of the city and caused the air quality in Miri to deteriorate to "Very Unhealthy" level according to the IPU (Air Pollution Index). Particularly on the 18 Aug, the API reading has soared to 228. For the past few weeks, the Fire & Rescue Dept Miri (BOMBA) and Dept of Environment Malaysia (DOE) have been actively carrying out operation to combat the wild fires around Miri. Being aware of the fire-fighting operation by the authorities in concern, DMR has taken an initiative to donate some food and drinks to the BOMBA and DOE officers on duty at site. Led by Mr. Lim VK, DMR had delivered a number of boxes containing mineral water with snacks to their base of operation near to the Kompleks Kebajikan Hamidah Yakup. This simple contribution and humanitarian assistance from DMR was well received and greatly appreciated by the officers from these two authorities (BOMBA & DOE).
