DONATION OF TO THE SCHOOLS THAT AFFECTED BY MAJOR FLOOD IN
BINTULU ON 29.01.2025

Major Flood happened in Bintulu on the 29th of Jan 2025 which had affected most of the schools that cause severe damage to the schools' items such as tables, chairs, school canteen chillers, stand fans etc. Daiken Sarawak Sdn. Bhd. (DSK) has taken the initiative to help the schools by approached the Tuan Haji Samri bin Suhaili, the Education District Officer of Bintulu (Head) to get some information about the schools that has been majorly affected by the floods.

3 schools have been chosen to receive the donation from Daiken Sarawak Sdn. Bhd. which is Sekolah Kebangsaan Sg. Genaan, Ulu Sebauh, Sekolah Kebangsaan Sg. Selah, Kuala Tatau and Sekolah Kebangsaan Kampung Nyalau, Samalaju.

On the 9 July 2025, Daiken delivered 1 unit of 2-doors Chiller (canteen usage) & 4 units of stand fans (student's dormitory usage) to Sekolah Kebangsaan Sg. Genaan at Ulu Sebauh which is located 80KM (about 1.5 hours journey) from DSK factory. The items were received by the Headmaster of the Schools which is Encik Halil together with his team.

On the 16 July 2025, Daiken delivered 35 sets of students' tables and chairs, 4 units of teacher's table and 4 units of banquet chairs to Sekolah Kebangsaan Sg. Selad at Kuala Tatau which is located 40KM (about 45 minutes journey) from DSK factory. The items were received by the Senior Assistant of Headmaster of the Schools together with his team.
